
Camp David Accords - Background Information & Geographic Setting

1948	New nation of formed
	Land carved from area called Palestine;
	Armistice lines drawn but never intended to be permanent boundaries
	Neighbors (, Jordan, and Syria) accept lines
1967	Six Day War
	Israel launches war of expansion in many directions
	Israel conquers the Peninsula from Egypt
	The Golan Heights, Gaza, and the West Bank also taken
	U.S. was strong ally of; Egypt and Syria were allies of the
1973	Yom Kippur War (or 1973 War)
	Israel's Arab neighbors try to get land back
	launches war to regain Sinai Peninsula; Syria also attacks Israel, hoping to regain Golan Heights region
	Arab nations resent U.S. support of Israel; launch embargo
	Tension remains high throughout the Middle East
1978	Camp David Accords
	U.S. President hosts historic summit between (led by Menachem Begin) and (led by Anwar Sadat)
	Agreement reached in September; signed in March 1979
